CENTER AGAINST RAPE AND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE and attaches hereto a duplicate original of the Articles of Consolidation.



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned natural persons of the age of 18 years or more, acting as incorporators under the Oregon Nonprofit Corporation Law, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is the Center Against Rape and Domestic Violence and its duration shall be perpetual.

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ARTICLE II

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are exclusively charitable and educational, including but not limited to:

- (A) Providing shelter, care and confidential personal support to victims of domestic violence, rape and related crimes, and
- (B) Educating the community concerning issues surrounding rape and domestic violence.

The powers of the corporation shall be exercised exclusively for charitable and educational purposes in such manner that the corporation shall qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as it is currently and shall thereafter be in force and effect.

ARTICLE III

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 216 SW Madison, Corvallis, Oregon, 97333, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Stan Robson.

. ARTICLE IV

ARTICLE V

ARTICLE VI

The provisions for the distribution of assets on dissolution or final liquidation are: After paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the Corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed to one or more nonprofit corporations or organizations engaged in activities substantially similar to those of this corporation, which are organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes and which shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law).

ARTICLE VII

No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the Corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal and state income taxes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and applicable state law as the same may be amended from time to time.

ARTICLE VIII

The Corporation is formed solely for charitable and educational purposes. The Corporation is not organized, nor shall it be operated, for the primary purpose of generating pecuniary gain or profit and it will not distribute any gains, profits, or dividends to the Members thereof or to any individual, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in futherance of its specific and primary purposes. The property, assets, profits, and net income of the Corporation are irrevocably dedicated to charitable and educational purposes and no part of the profit or net income of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any Director, Officer, or Member thereof or to the benefit of any individual.

We the undersigned incorporators, declare under penalties of perjury, that we have examined the foregoing Articles of Incorporation and, to the best of our knowledge and belief, they are true, correct, and complete.
