Community Education



April is also Child Abuse Prevention Month. At CARDV, many of the survivors we work with have experienced sexual assault and/or child abuse. Unfortunately, it is not uncommon for intersections to occur with these forms of violence. According to RAINN (Rape, Abuse and Incest National Network):

- Every 73 seconds, a person in America is sexually assaulted
- Every 9 minutes, that person is a child
- Over 90% of child sexual abuse perpetrators are known to the child
- Ages 12-34 are the highest risk years for sexual assault

CARDV regularly presents to community groups such as churches, sororities, and healthcare providers to discuss CARDV's history, services, community impact, and how to get involved. We also present to schools in Linn and Benton Counties about healthy relationships and consent. Education is the key to prevention! You can help prevent sexual and domestic violence in our community by requesting a CARDV presentation.
