Survivors Move Forward Fund

Last year through a one-time Federal grant we assisted over 100 families with much needed funding. For Brenda and her 2 kids this was a game changer. She had enough income to pay for rent, but she was not able to save the extra needed to get into housing. This funding provided her deposit and first month's rent. For the first time in 7 years, she and her kids were able to move into a safe home of their own and start a fresh life free from violence.
