1. What is the Safe Families Benefit virtual event?

Every October, CARDV hosts a Safe Families Breakfast for Domestic Violence Awareness Month. This year's program will get a digital makeover, and slight name change. The program will be live-streamed via Facebook Live and YouTube this year.

2. When is the virtual event?

We will host the Safe Families Benefit virtual program on Tuesday, October 27th, 2020. The program will be approximately 30 minutes and will be shown at 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

3. How can I view the program?

The Safe Families Breakfast virtual program will be live-streamed on CARDV's Facebook page. The program will also be available for viewing through YouTube via a link that will be provided closer to the event.
